He Set His Face To Go To Jerusalem

- Jesus knows what is to come, Is 50:7
 - I have set My face like a flint (Lk 9:51)
- Movement, 16:13; 17:24; 19:1; 20:29; 21:1
- Walking ahead of them, Mk 10:32

Jesus Knows Your Fear

- It's nearing the Passover
- The disciples understand the danger of going to Jerusalem, not the significance
- They were amazed, Mk 10:32 (perplexed)
- They were afraid
- He took them unto Him, privately explaining, meeting them in their need

The Commitment Of The King



Matthew 20:18a

Christ's Commitment To The Scriptures

- See, behold, come to understand this
- Everything that is written about the Son of Man by the prophets will be accomplished, Lk 18:31
- I come to do Thy will, O Lord, Heb 10:7

Direct Predictions

- Zechariah 9:9, that He would enter into Jerusalem.
- Psalms 2, that He would know the fury and rage of His enemies.
- Zechariah 13:7, that He would be deserted by His friends.
- Zechariah 11:12, betrayed for thirty pieces of silver.
- Psalms 22:16, that He would be pierced on the cross.
- Exodus 12:46, none of His bones would be broken; Psalms 34:20.

Direct Predictions

- Psalm 22:18, they will cast lots for My garments
- Psalm 69:21 says He'll be given vinegar to drink.
- Psalm 22:1, He will cry out in the pain of distress.
- Zechariah 12:10 says they'll pierce Him with a spear.
- Psalm 16:10, that He will rise from the dead.
- Psalm 110:1 even says He'll ascend into heaven.

The Message Of The OT

- Sin separates us from God, Gen 3
 - A Seed would crush the serpent, 3:15
 - A covering by the life of an innocent other, 3:21
- On the Mount of the Lord it will be provided, Gen 22:14 (Moriah, 2 Chr 3:1); son you love
 - The LORD provides the substitutionary sacrifice
- Whole sacrificial system, Ex, Lev...

Jesus Loves *You*

- Suffered these things, Lk 24:26
 - Mental anguish of anticipation (Garden)
 - Betrayal by intimate ones, delivered over
 - Public opposition, priests/scribes
 - Condemnation though innocent, silent

Jesus Loves *You*

- Suffered these things, Lk 24:26
 - They mocked Him, spit, humiliation
 - Flogged, physical pain
 - Death, bearing the full weight of sin
 - The lack of friendship comfort in His need

The Conquering King

Our Unconquerable Lord

- He will be raised!
- Because it was Impossible for death to keep its hold on him, Ac 2:24
- The substitutionary sacrifice as payment for sin has been accepted *in full*
